#### **OVERVIEW**

Farms to Food Banks funds help Kentucky farmers recoup losses for fresh, edible agricultural products that they otherwise would not be able to sell due to minor blemishes or size discrepancies. This nourishing food is distributed free of charge to Kentuckians in need, where it would otherwise go to waste.
